What is Kadesh?

The Kades project takes its name from the Kadesh peace treaty signed between Ancient Egypt and the Hittites in 1285 BC. The Kadesh agreement is the first known written agreement in history.







Kadesh uses blue as the main color in its corporate identity and logo, as it represents Trust and Loyalty.




Kadesh uses sooty black as the second main color in its corporate identity and logo to represent the finality in agreements.

The Spathy

The Spathy symbol takes its name from the Latin word Spathiphyllum, the Flower of Peace.






Chain Ring


The Spathy symbol consists of two interlocking chain rings. The intertwined and entangled rings represent Kadesh's closed-loop blockchain.





When two intertwined rings come together in the Spathy symbol, it represents two people shaking hands and making deals.






Deal Table

The square in the middle of the Spathy symbol (the red shaded area) represents the deal table.








Equal Darties


The rectangular areas on the sides of the Spathy symbol (the areas shaded in red) represent four equal parties making a deal.
